For the past 55 years The Slinger Advancement Association has worked to promote and improve the Village of Slinger. The hard work and efforts of our volunteers have made it possible to be a positive contributor in our community. A few of our current achievements are as follows:

- \$1000 annual SAA Scholarship given to a deserving Slinger High School student, nominated by the SHS principal, initiated by Jim Crovetti and given annually since 2006.
- Annual Scholarship given to deserving student to attend Badger Girls State Program.
- \$1,500 given to the Slinger Fire Dept. in 2005 to enhance their Dive Team program.
- \$15,000 given to Slinger Rotary in 2006 for building of the new concession stands and parking lot paving at the Slinger Community Park.
- \$6,000 paid to the Village of Slinger in 2006, to purchase the land St. Peter's church owned, land being used by baseball diamonds.
- \$1,500 given to Slinger High School to 'Light the Soccer Field Project 2007'.
- \$1,500 given to the Slinger High School 2006 for the band trip to Hawaii. The band performed in the Christmas Parade.
- \$3,534 given to the Slinger Police Dept. in 2007 for new video camera equipment mandated by law.
